Getting Involved

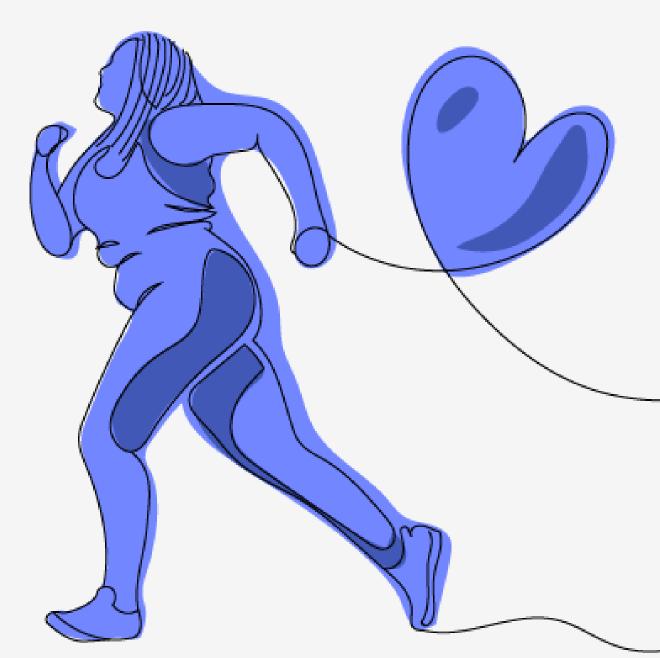
1. Choose Your Fundraising Activity

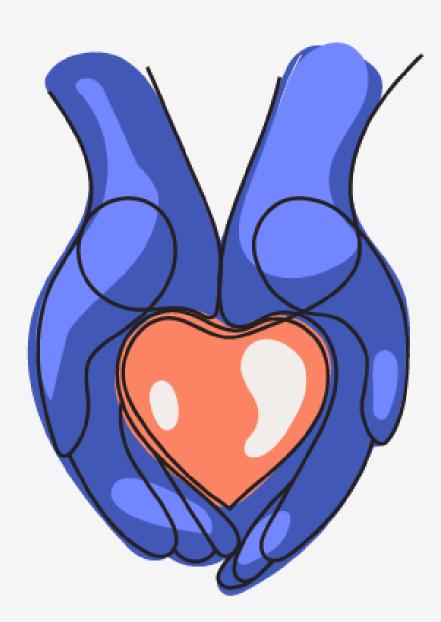

- Get permission for public events or venues
- Use cashless donation tools where possible
- Clearly label food (allergens)
- ✓ Never pressure anyone to donate, just invite them to be part of the cause

Quick Activity Guides

Bake Sale

- Hold at home, school, work or in your community
- Promote ahead of time
- Provide a cashless payment option if possible (QR codes to fundraising page)
- Share photos to encourage more donations

Sponsored Walk, Run or Cycle

- Set a challenge that works for you solo or as a group
- Promote your challenge and invite sponsorship
- Track your progress, post updates & celebrate at the finish line

<u>Declutter & Donate</u>

- Clear out items you no longer need
- Sell through eBay, Facebook Marketplace, Vinted, Depop or local market
- Donate the proceeds to your fundraising page & let people know they're helping a great cause by buying from you!

Quick Activity Guides

Quiz Night

- Host online or in person
- Prepare fun quiz rounds (general knowledge, music, pop culture)
- Ask for donations as an entry fee
- Offer a small prize for the winner
- Share photos and results afterwards

Craft Sale or Art Auction

- Create and sell handmade crafts, cards, prints, or digital art
- Sell online, at local markets, or through friends and family
- Set suggested donation amounts or invite people to bid/offer
- Share your creations online and tag us so we can cheer you on

Quick Activity Guides

Online Gaming / Streaming Marathon

- Host a marathon gaming session or "sponsor me to beat this game" challenge
- Stream on Twitch, YouTube or Facebook
- Promote your fundraising page in your stream
- Keep supporters updated and celebrate milestones during the event

Birthday Fundraiser

- Ask for donations in lieu of gifts for your birthday this year
- Set up a birthday-themed fundraising page
- Share why supporting the PDA community matters to you
- Thank your supporters with a personal message or social post
